To provide candidates with hands-on experience of enjoying activities conducted for children, helping them understand the elements required to design and conduct engaging activities in their Anganwadis.



Work with Natural Resources

To help candidates realize the abundance of resources around them, and use them to create sustainable teaching aids for Anganwadi Children.

MTs conduct regular training for AWs and Parents

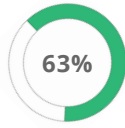


MTs act as community leads, helping AWs and Parents support each other in helping their children grow and learn sustainably.

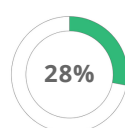

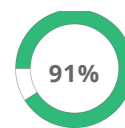
